DEPARTMENT REPORTS

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief John Huff gave the monthly report for October. This report detailed 293 total calls. Traffic activity included 70 citations, 4 OMVI, 33 written warnings, 17 parking citations and 52 verbal warnings. **Risk Management** included 56 hours of training on non-emergency call handling, emergency medical dispatch, basic fire communications, search & seizure updates, and victims of crime.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Chief Horton announced that the fire department has received an EMS grant from the State of Ohio for \$5500.00.

TRUSTEES

Ray Schulte announced that Diane Pajk passed away last week after a long battle with cancer. Diane had served Hinckley Township for 16 years on the zoning board. Diane will definitely be missed.

Ray Schulte stated that the township has three open positions on the zoning boards. The trustees would like residents to contact the townhall if they are interested in one of the zoning board positions.

Mr. Schulte stated that Commissioner Sharon Ray was recently named "Elected Official of the Year" by the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce.

The township is requesting nominations for Citizen of the Year.

Ron Garapick made a motion to adopt **Resolution #112607-01** which approves entering into an agreement where Hinckley Township agrees to purchase and the Board of Commissioners of Medina County agrees to sell materials from time to time that are required for construction, maintenance, or repair of any Hinckley Township road or building. Ron Rhodes seconded. Vote: S-yes, G-yes, R-yes. The trustees signed the agreement.

FISCAL OFFICER

Colleen Swedyk reported that the Township currently has funds totaling \$3,377,779.48.

FLOOR

John Moner appeared before the trustees to express his concerns over a dog that continually barks in his neighbor's yard. This has been very disruptive for his family especially since his wife has some health problems. Mr. Moner has talked to the police several times. Chief Huff stated that the County Prosecutor is now working on a noise ordinance for the township. Once the ordinance is in place, this may give the township more authority to handle this problem.
