

Chairman Jim Burns called the November 5, 2018 Public Hearing of the Hinckley Township Board of Trustees to order at 5:30 p.m. Present were Trustees Jim Burns, Becky Lutzko and Ray Schulte, 30 residents and three reporters.

Mr. Burns stated this public hearing is for the purpose of reviewing an application for text and map amendments submitted by David Properties Limited and the Pavluk Limited Family Partnership.

At this time Mr. Burns turned the floor over to Hinckley’s outside zoning consultant George Smerigan. Mr. Smerigan outlined the history of the amendment requests. He explained that Terry Properties had been authorized to act as an agent on behalf of the property owners in requesting the text and map amendments. He announced that the township has received additional correspondence from the owner of the property- the Pavluk Limited Family Partnership- rescinding the authorization enabling Terry Properties to act on their behalf. Based on that email Terry Properties no longer has standing in this matter. Based on that information, he recommended that the trustees cancel and close the public hearing on the two zoning amendments and, he further recommended that at the regular meeting the trustees entertain a motion to dismiss both amendments.

Burns made a motion that the Board of Trustees abandon the two requested zoning amendments and close this public hearing on the two amendments scheduled for today and further consider dismissing both zoning amendments at its next regular Trustee Meeting. Schulte second. Vote: B-yes, L-yes, S-yes.

Mr. Burns adjourned the public hearing at 5:33 p.m.
